# Pass Criteria

#### **Puppies Pass Criteria**

Handler is able to get and hold dog's attention
Handler understands how to use clicker or marker word and how to 'get the timing right' when rewarding their dog. Handler understands how to play with their dog as a reward using toy and/or body
Use of food, etc as a reward will still be on a high rate but luring to get behaviour has been faded for the following exercises
3 step heeling without losing attention
Sit – at left side (position for sit, drop, and stand does not need to be perfect, just needs to be on the left side)
Drop – at left side
Stand – at left side
Turns – Handler to know how to execute left, left-about and right, right-about turns
10 second sit stay and 10 second down stay
Informal recall

# **Beginners One Pass Criteria**

# **Beginners Two Pass Criteria**

Handler is able to get and hold dog's attention
Handler understands how to use clicker or marker word and how to 'get the timing right' when rewarding their dog
Handler understands how to play with their dog as a reward using toy and/or body
3 step heeling without losing attention and without luring
Sit – at left side, no luring, and working towards automatic
Drop – at left side with no luring
Stand – at left side with no luring
Stand stay (10 sec) at left side with no lure (no return)
15 second sit stay
20 second down stay
Formal recall – dog will sit and wait, sit in front position, and hold for return
Turns – handler knows how to execute left, right, left-about, and right-about turns in traditional style and can do so with a loose lead
Reinforcement with food, play, praise to be encouraged

#### **Pink Pass Criteria**

	Exercises to be performed without lure. Variable rewarding
	continues to be encouraged
	Short heeling pattern on a loose leash including all turns, sits
	stands, and downs. The heeling should be of sufficient standard to
	demonstrate handler & dog are working solidly towards off-lead
	work. Turns should be acute (90o or 180o). Sits, stands, and downs
	should be performed with near correct position
	Stand stay on lead – 20 seconds with return

#### **Yellow Pass Criteria**

Heeling with loose lead of good standard. Tight leads and any correction with lead must in incur a penalty in Competition
Sits, downs, stands, all turns, and slow and fast pace to be executed in the heeling exercise. These should all be near, but not quite at, the standard that will be expected in CCD
Stand for examination – Brief (includes return)
Recall on lead. Dog to come without guidance from lead (no return)
Finish of recall (judged as a separate exercise)
1 minute group Sit Stay on lead
2 minute group Down Stay on lead
