Many thanks also to Kurt Muldoon for transporting the equipment on its last leg to FDOC. This equipment, A-frame, Dogwalk and Seesaw, is made of aluminium and so much lighter than the old timber set. Given that we are mostly women participating in agility, we are very appreciative.

On 19th March after training at FDOC, we organised an excursion to the K9 Agility Club trial at KCC Park. Those who attended learned a great deal about agility, not just competition. They found it most exciting and interesting to watch the wide variety of performances 🙄 I think we gained a couple of trial converts that day.

The next Foundation 1 course will most likely begin after the Funday in late May.
